USE & CARE GUIDELINES FOR POLYGOOD



CDUK recommends using the following products and guidelines to clean, maintain and care for your Polygood surfaces.

Surface dirt can easily be removed using a mild detergent and warm water.

If material requires a more intensive clean, try the following solutions in order:

- 1. Use a neat detergent on a cloth, making sure that it is a detergent compatible with the plastic as per the guidelines below which will not damage it.
- 2. If this fails, use isopropanol liquid cleaner following the manufacturers guidelines.
- 3. If these steps do not work, use a scouring cream such as Bar Keepers Friend® Cream with a micro fibre cloth or sponge.

Avoid using squeegees or a dry cloth on the materials they may create scratches by dragging debris across the surface.

Use of an abrasive cleaner on darker colours or a high gloss finish may result in a dull appearance that may require repolishing.

Polygood panels are sensitive to organic solvents, especially to acetone or products based on acetone and some ethanol-based cleaning detergents. Avoid using such products on Polygood surfaces.

Scuffs can be polished out using a mildly abrasive cleaner such as Bar Keepers Friend® Cream. Scratches on Polygood can be sanded out using appropriate grades of paper and scotch pads. You may require the services of a fabricator or installer to help you with this.
